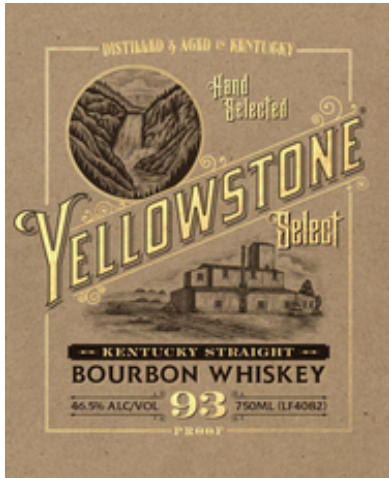

Yellowstone Select Bourbon 93 proof

Stephen B. Beam - "Yellowstone has been reborn. A true family affair, in 1910 my father's grandfather, Minor Case Beam, sold his Old Trump Distillery to Joseph Bernard Dant, pioneer distiller and relative to my mother, and began producing Yellowstone at the distillery. I am proud to welcome the Yellowstone brand back to our family 105 years later." The new distillery by Steve and Paul Beam, **Limestone Branch Distillery**, opened in 2010 in Lebanon Kentucky, it is up and running with its craft sized production of 1 barrel a day - a capacity of just 40,000 proof gallons a year.

The **Select Bourbon** is a beautiful marriage of 4 and 7 year old stocks of Kentucky Straight Bourbon barrels. It has won several notable awards including a platinum medal at the 2017 SIP Awards and gold at the 2017 Berlin Spirits Competition.

Deep golden chestnut hue. Leather and dried fruit on the nose with a slight hint of citrus and smoky oak. Spicy rye on the palate with a whisper of dried cherries fading to smoked caramel. A memorable finish, rich with brown sugar and Kentucky tradition.



Yellowstone 2017 Limited Edition Charred Wine Barrel Finished Bourbon, 101 proof

Limestone Branch Distillery introduces the 2017 version of Yellowstone® Limited Edition Kentucky Straight Bourbon, finished in charred wine casks. This year's limited edition combines hand-selected, seven and 12-year Kentucky Straight bourbons, with a special addition of Limestone Branch Distillery's first available, 4-year Kentucky Straight bourbon. The bourbon is then rested in once-filled, double seasoned barrels, which are toasted and then lightly charred.

Bottled at 101 proof and available in 750ml bottles signed by Steve Beam and nestled in commemorative tubes, Yellowstone Limited Edition offers an earthy flavor, dark and rich, with a nose of toasted oak, caramel and butterscotch at the front of the palette, giving way to rich leather and dark summer fruit on the finish.

DISTILLER: The 4-year old is from Limestone Branch, while the 7 and 12 year old whiskies are most likely Heaven Hill

MASH BILL: 7 year = 75% Corn | 13% Rye | 12% Malt; 12 year = 75% Corn | 13% Rye | 12% Malt; 4 year* = 75% Local Heirloom White Corn | 13% Rye | 12% Malt

AGE: NAS - but includes a blend of 4*, 7 and 12 year-old Kentucky straight bourbons

YEAR: 2017

PROOF: 101 (50.5% ABV)

Calumet Single Rack Black 10yr Bourbon



In 1924, William Monroe Write, a successful entrepreneur and owner of Calumet Baking Powder Company, established a farm in the beautiful Bluegrass pasturelands of Lexington Kentucky. The farm would go on to win 8 Kentucky Derbies and 2 Triple Crowns. It's with these high standards that Calumet Farm Bourbon Whiskey embodies the tradition and excellence of Kentucky Bourbon and thoroughbred racing.

Calumet Farm Bourbon Whiskey is Kentucky-aged to perfection for over 10 years bottled from hand selected barrels on a single rack (19 barrels) in the rick house. Calumet has a customary mash bill of corn, rye and malted barley that offers a sweet, flawless finish, glowing with butterscotch and vanilla. A harmonious perfection of wood and time, this whiskey brims with citrus and toasty aromas followed by apple skin and baking spice. The palate shows complex flavors of soft toasted oak, brown sugar and a touch of spice. Each bottle boasts a hand-written, custom label with the specific rack location and number of barrels in that bottling.

MASH BILL: 74% Corn, 18% Rye, and 8% Malted Barley
